Islington Advice Alliance is made up of 3 key advice agencies in Islington; Islington Citizens Advice Bureau (Islington CAB), Islington Law Centre, and Islington People's Rights. Brief details of the services offered by IAA Members are detailed below.

Islington CAB provides free, independent advice on:

- Welfare benefits, including benefit checks, applications and appeals
- Debt problems, Debt Relief Orders and bankruptcy applications
- Housing problems, including tenancy issues and repairs
- Employment problems, such as redundancy, unfair dismissal and discrimination
- Utilities problems, issues with suppliers of gas, electric and water
- Consumer Problems, like faulty goods and complaints.
